What is Domestic and Family Violence?

Patterns of behaviour that include

- Physical and/or sexual assault
- Verbal abuse & insults
- Social isolation
- Financial control
- Emotional abuse

Patterns of behaviour that include:

- Rape
- Incest
- Child abuse
- Any unwanted behaviour such as unwanted touching and kissing
